



Required Documentation

- Proof of a Developmental Disability:
 - It must be a signed psychological assessment or report that uses standardized assessment tools; and
 - It must clearly state that you have significant limitations in cognitive and adaptive functioning as defined in the Services and Supports to Promote the Social Inclusion of Persons with a Developmental Disabilities Act, 2008.
- **Proof of Age** (one of the following documents):
 - o Statement of Live Birth, Birth or Baptismal Certificate;
 - o Passport or Certificate of Canadian Citizenship or Naturalization
 - Driver's Licence
 - Ontario Health Card (cannot be used for both proof of age and Ontario residency)
 - Old Age Security Card
 - o Certificate of Indian Status or Registered Indian Record
 - Valid Ontario Photo Card
 - Protected Person Status document
 - Written confirmation from Citizenship and Immigration Canada that the person is eligible to apply for Canadian citizenship under Section 5.1 of the Citizenship Act
 - Valid Permanent Resident Card or Permanent Resident Card expired not more than five years
- Proof of Legal Ontario Residency (one of the following documents):
 - Valid Ontario Health Card or Ontario Photo Card
 - Mortgage, rental or lease agreement
 - Statement of direct deposit for Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP) or Old Age Security T4A (OAS) or Ontario Works (OW)
 - Employer record (pay stub or letter from employer on company letterhead)
 - Mailed bank account statements (does not include automated teller receipts or bank books)
 - o Utility bill (home telephone, cable TV, hydro, gas, water)
 - Ontario Driver's Licence or temporary licence
 - o School/college/university report card or transcript
 - Statement of Canada Pension Plan Benefits T4A (P)
 - Statement of Employment Insurance Benefits Paid T4E
 - o Ontario Motor Vehicle Permit

- **Proof of Legal Ontario Residency** continued (one of the following documents):
 - o Child Tax Benefit Statement
 - o Insurance Policy (home, tenant, auto or life)
 - Statement of RRSP, RRIF, or RHOSP from a financial institution
